

Secretariat Policy #5: Contents of Fourth Day Packet

Background:

Each candidate on a weekend traditionally receives a “Fourth Day Packet” containing information designed to help the new Pescadores live their Fourth Days better. In the past, the contents were specified in the By-Laws, making it difficult to change to match changing circumstances. At the same time, the list of contents has stood the test of many weekends. To balance these needs, the content list has been moved from the By-Laws to this official policy.

Policy Overview:

This policy applies to the contents of the Men’s, Women’s and Bi-Cultural weekends put on by the Community. It is intended to serve as a guide for the Vida Nueva weekends.

The Fourth Day Packet shall contain the following. The media may be either paper, CD-ROM or other electronic media as selected by the Committee in charge of the packet.

- (1) Living the Fourth Day booklet
- (2) Blank applications
- (3) Roster of candidates/team
- (4) Welcome Letter from the Lay Director
- (5) Copy of *The Essentials of Tres Dias*
- (6) Local by-laws
- (7) Latest copy of the Fourth Day News
- (8) “What is Tres Dias” pamphlet
- (9) List of the scheduled Secretariat meetings and upcoming weekends.
