

So, what do you have to do to attend...

Anyone who wishes to participate should be sponsored by someone who has previously completed a Tres Dias weekend. Your sponsor carries significant responsibility to assure that your family is taken care of, so that you can focus on the activities of the weekend and not worry about what's happening at home.

The only requirement is that an application form be completed, and signed by your sponsor. Once this is filled out, he/she will do the rest. If you do not have a sponsor, we will be happy to find one for you.

History of Tres Dias...

Tres Dias was derived from Cursillo de Christianidad, a "short course in Christianity" and has been involved in church renewal since its beginnings in Spain. The first "Cursillo de Christianidad" occurred in 1949 in Majorca, Spain. Translated from Spanish, Tres Dias means "Three Days." Tres Dias is an ecumenical & inter-denominational Christian renewal group that "Proclaims that Jesus Christ is Lord."

In the US, Tres Dias was started in 1972, and is overseen and chartered by Tres Dias International, which is made up of laity and clergy from around the world. Individual weekends are sponsored and coordinated by local area groups.

Weekends for men and women are held throughout the year. Tres Dias encourages people to be in small groups to support each other in their lives as Christians while maintaining ties with their home churches and other Christian communities.

There are now more than 70 Tres Dias communities around the world. Tens of thousands of men and women have attended a Tres Dias Weekend and have become more committed to serving our Lord Jesus.

The Seoul Tres Dias community hosts two English speaking Men's, two English speaking Women's, and one Bi-Cultural Women's weekends yearly.

The weekends run from Thursday evening through Sunday afternoon. In addition to other participants, the weekend consists of committed Christian volunteers who serve as team members. They will attempt to share the "Christ within them" with the participants, while expecting nothing in return.



Tres Dias IS...

✝ An opportunity for adult Christians to have a 3-day encounter with Christ, experience other Christians serving them in love, and receive new inspiration for living a life in Christ. Some may want to call it a retreat, but it does not have the solitude of a retreat.

✝ A weekend focused on God's "unmerited love." It is designed to show the "agape" type love that God pours out on us. This is love that is unconditional, undeserved, and for which the only true response can be to love others in return.

✝ The goal is to empower Christians to become leaders within their families, their small groups, their churches, and their communities.

✝ Protestant counter-part of the Catholic Cursillo movement. However, many Catholics are active in both organizations, and this also assists in the breaking down of denominational walls. The things which Christian denominations have in common are emphasized, and those which are different, are respected.

✝ A time when open communion is practiced, and anyone who acknowledges Jesus Christ as Lord is welcome to partake.

✝ A "once-in-a-lifetime" experience.

Once a person has attended a weekend, he/she becomes a ✝Pescador (fisherman). Pescadores are not permitted to attend again, unless they do so as a future team member. Following the weekend, they are strongly encouraged to participate in small "home groups" (referred to in Tres Dias lingo as "reunion groups").

Tres Dias Is NOT...

It is **NOT** intended to become an alternative to your home church or practice of worship.

It is **NOT** a denomination, nor is it designed to become a focal point of worship.

It is **NOT** intended to resolve psychological or emotional problems, nor is it group therapy.

It is **NOT** for everyone.

Things to Expect...

- 15 dynamic talks given by community members as well as clergy
- Times of prayer, sharing and fellowship
- Lots of music and singing
- Lots of fun and surprises!
- LOTS of food. (This isn't the weekend to plan a fast or begin a diet!)
- More surprises!!!

But, most importantly, you can expect that God will meet you exactly where you are!

Tres Dias weekends are open to...

- Christians who are at least 21 years old (18+ for active duty military)
- Anyone who has NOT already attended a Tres Dias (or similar 3-Day weekend)
- Married or single men and women
- Members of the clergy
- Anyone who wants to look seriously at themselves, their relationship with other people, and their relationship with God
