Vida Nueva



Vida Nueva (a Spanish term for "New Life") is an interdenominational youth oriented encounter similar to the Cursillo and Tres Dias movements. It is a weekend filled with faith, fun, and fellowship. Talks are presented on a wide variety of topics by a working team. The subject matter and activities are challenging and thought provoking, leading to open-ended discussions in small and large groups.

Any student in the 9th grade thru the 12th and with the maturity and willingness to experience the spiritual dimension of life and share thoughts with others can attend Vida Nueva. At Vida Nueva, we call the attendees cordero's (Spanish for lamb) as we are all lambs on this journey of life with a shepherd. Priority is given to SOFA/MOFA students from the community in Korea on a first come first served basis.

Vida Nueva normally begins on a Friday and ends on a Sunday. It is held twice a year: once in the Fall (preferably over the Thanksgiving weekend) and once in the Spring during April. Vida Nueva is held at the Eighth US Army Religious Retreat Center (RRC) on Namsan in Seoul. The RRC is a small post close to Yongsan, about ten minutes east.

A Vida Nueva team is a group of spiritually energized teens and adults drawn from the Christian community. They meet for two months in prayer and preparation for this weekend encounter with Christ. Their goals are to seek answers to each and every question possible concerning one's Christian walk, to develop a lively Christian community, and to join the community in such a loving and supportive way that others are encouraged in their spiritual growth.
